## JOIN AVODAH'S JEWISH SERVICE CORPS

Corps Members, ages 21-26, spend a service year working at a local non-profit while living and learning in pluralistic Jewish community. They receive a monthly living stipend, furnished housing, health insurance, a travel allowance, an exit stipend, and access to our Economic Access Fund throughout their year of professional development in the justice field.

**Create lasting, pluralistic Jewish community.** Home-cooked meals, late night conversations, and holiday celebrations make communal living memorable and meaningful.

**Launch your career in social justice.** Gain hands-on experience by serving on the ground at one of our placement organizations tackling crucial justice issues such as the criminal legal system, immigration, climate justice, education, and food insecurity.

**Dive into deep learning.** Through innovative programming, you'll explore how to live out your justice values, the role of community in creating a more just world, and what role your Jewish identity plays in your life and work.

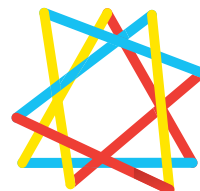
