Corps Members, ages 21-26, receive a monthly living stipend, travel allowance, health insurance, furnished housing, and an exit stipend throughout their year of professional development in the justice field.

AS A CORPS MEMBER, YOU'LL:

Create lasting Jewish community. Home-cooked meals, late night conversations, and holiday celebrations make communal living memorable and meaningful. Jews of Color (JOCs) can choose to build community in the JOC Bayit, an affinity space within the Service Corps.

Launch your career in social justice. Serve on the ground at one of our partner organizations tackling crucial justice issues such as immigration, housing, healthcare, or education.

Dive into deep learning. Through experiential programming, you'll explore different visions for movements for justice, the role of community in creating a more just world, and how you want to show up as a Jew in justice work.

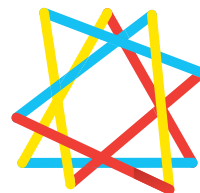
